*Every year in December, eight very special children receive a Children of Courage Award from the Duchess of Kent at Westminster Abbey, London. This is a way of recognising the children's bravery in dealing with dangerous situations, including saving lives. The following is one of the eight stories about brave kids published by the British magazine WOMAN'S OWN.*

When two dangerous armed burglars attacked her dad, eight-year-old Radha Patel rushed to save him.

The drama began one evening in April when the two men ran into the family's shop, The Daily News, in Southsea, Hants. Armed with a 10-inch knife, one of them came behind the counter where Radha's dad was standing, and demanded cash. When he refused, the first man knocked him to the ground and punched him twice in the face while the second man tried to force open the till.

It was too much for Radha. Even though she'd seen one of the men threatening her dad with the knife, she punched him, pulled his hair and hit his face.

"I was so angry, I just did it - even though he was twice as big as me," says Radha.

When his daughter attacked the men, Mr Patel, 42, was able to pull himself up from the floor to push the panic button. The shop was filled with the high-decibel alarm and the surprised burglars ran away. The brave girl chased them halfway down the street.

"I get very upset thinking about this incident. Fortunately for my husband and all of us, Radha was there," says proud mum, Mrs Patel, 40. "Now I'm so scared for him that I stay in the shop with him after 6.30 p.m."

Thanks to her bravery, Radha's dad escaped with just a swollen face and bloodied nose.

Detective Sergeant Keith Davies from Hampshire Police says, "Radha behaved very bravely. I highly praise her action in defending her dad."
