She went to clubs and restaurants watching the dealer and pretending to enjoy herself! Her long hair was an advantage, it was great for disguises. Because she looked feminine, criminals assumed she was harmless. They didn't know it 20 was a police officer who could rugby-tackle them!

Nowadays Angela misses that world, but it left her no time to have a personal life. Now she has a family, but she still likes to help if she can.
